



#### **Auction Notification**

SIDHartA Auctioneer is an official auction that is monitored by the Office of Auctions of the Direktorat Jendral Kekayaan Negara Indonesia . An Auction Registrar, Jimmy Novianto Suryadi is present on behalf of the Office of Auctions to monitor that the auction is run properly, provide an official report to the government and ensure that the winning bidders comply with their part, ie make payment in full and in due time.

This auction is a regular Continental Style auction. Bidders bid the lots they desire until the highest bid is reached. There is a 22% buyer's premium charged on top of hammer price that is to be paid by the winning bidder in addition to the hammer price itself.

You will find the lots to be auctioned in sequence, starting from the lowest number to the highest number. Live online auction usually goes at a rate of 50 lots perhour. 49 lots should take around 59 minutes.

The estimate price of the lot reflects roughly the current price of the artworks, meaning in normal circumstances, a bidder placing a bid within the range of the estimate should be able to win the lot, unless there is unusual competition. However, depending on demand, a bidder may also be able to win the lot at a price either lower than the low estimate (at the reserve price), or even win the piece at a price higher than the high estimate.

Most of the lots do have a reserve, a minimum limit price at which the owner/ vendor of the lot agrees to let go of the lot. Auctioneer is allowed to execute bidding up to the reserve, on behalf of the owner/vendor of the lot. That is what is going on when bidding has started, and the Auctioneer counters the bid by saying that a bid of a certain lot is still "with me". Until bidding reaches the reserve, a lot cannot be considered sold. So a lot is only considered sold if it has already reached the reserve.

Bidding does not stop only until the reserve is reached, but it continues until the highest bid has been reached and the auctioneer will count up to three to make sure that there are no more bids. The Auctioneer will strike the hammer strike is to signify that the lot has been sold and call out the paddle number of the bidder and the hammer price. We commonly have Written Bids, Phone Bids and Online Bids. Our operators on the phone will execute bids on behalf of the phone bidders who are monitoring the auction via the phone. Absentee Written Bids have also been placed with the Auctioneer and they have been registered in the auction book. Online Bids are executed automatically via the internet.

The Auctioneer will execute the Absentee Bids up to the limit that they have provided, and you will also hear that the absentee bid is "with me", and the Auctioneer will indicate that the bid is a Written Bid that is left by an Absentee bidder. So, bidders on the floor will be also competing with Absentee Bidders who have left their bids with us, phone bidders, and online bidders.

The lot in the auctions are sold as is and condition reports of each lot is available upon request. You should have consulted the works that you want to buy. If there are certain mistakes in the wording of the information of the lots in the catalog, we will put them up in Sale Room Notices.

Certificates: We are not authorized, do not and will not publish certificates. So unless there is mention of certificates in the auction catalog, please do not expect to obtain any certificates from us.

Our office operates from Tuesday to Saturday; therefore, you should receive the invoice inclusive the 22% premium by today or at the latest on Tuesday or Wednesday.



# In The Garden by Arifien "Neif"


Arifien Neif, one of Indonesia's most celebrated painters, is renowned for his deeply emotive, introspective works that often explore the intersections of personal identity, romantic idealism, and cultural heritage. Born in Surabaya, Indonesia, in 1955, Neif grew up in a period of socio-political change, which deeply influenced his artistic vision. His works reflect not only personal emotion but also the broader narrative of Indonesian culture, often drawing on traditional elements to juxtapose with modern concerns.

Neif's artistic career blossomed as Indonesia's modern art scene gained momentum. Deeply inspired by classical Indonesian aesthetics, his style is often characterized as a blend of realism and romanticism. Neif's works typically showcase intimate domestic scenes, capturing tender moments between individuals or solitary figures in reflection. His mastery lies in his ability to convey profound emotion through small gestures and subtle details, often infusing a poetic quality into his subjects.

Often, his subjects are depicted within the confines of their homes, as if suspended in time, allowing viewers to peer into moments of vulnerability or quiet contemplation. This domestic intimacy has become a signature aspect of his work, often creating a sense of warmth and closeness that contrasts with the sense of isolation experienced by his figures. The women in Neif's paintings, in particular, are rendered with grace and sensitivity. He frequently portrays them as both fragile and resilient, capturing an inner strength beneath their poised exteriors.


This particular painting stands out in Neif's oeuvre, not just for its subject but for its departure from his usual compositional choices. The painting features an elegant lady sitting atop a hill, her figure both serene and captivating against the backdrop of the natural landscape. While a house appears in the background, it is no longer the central motif, as is common in much of Neif's work. Instead, the focal point is the lady herself, whose demure demeanor and graceful posture command attention. The hilltop setting evokes a sense of freedom and tranquility, yet the lady's calm, composed expression hints at a quiet introspection, typical of Neif's portrayal of his subjects.

The juxtaposition of the house in the background with the lady's solitary figure on the hill adds layers to the narrative. The house symbolizes the familiar theme of domestic life, yet its placement in the distance suggests a departure from the confines of the interior space, perhaps a metaphorical exploration of personal freedom or an escape from societal expectations. The lady's elegance and quiet dignity remain the focal point, representing the romantic idealism Neif so often portrays — a figure that is both ethereal and grounded, balancing the weight of personal emotion with the tranquility of the external world.


## Laskar Oren by Dede Eri Supria

The image of the workers, particularly the orange-vested (hence their appalation "Pasukan Oren" garbage cleaner troop members of Jakarta, is another of Dede Eri Supria's most favorite subjects.

While four of his colleagues rigorously and tirelessly sweep the pavement in a Jakarta neighborhood, a member of the orange troop is drinking a bottle of mineral water.

Through this image, the artist not only seems to be saying that even our heroes are human beings who need to rest and refresh themselves. but also, he seems to be addressing a concern about garbage management: what will happen to the plastic bottle from which the man drank his water? WIII it be recycled? The artist not only glorifies the garbage man as our hero, he also wants people to be fully aware of waste and its ramifications to our society.

In this remarkably unique painting Dede Eri Supria does not render the iconic image of the world famous lone horse rider ("the Marlboro Man"), nor the members of the orange vested garbage cleaning troop, nor the clowns who try to amuse and entertain Jakarta urbanites. Instead he paints the harvesting activities of farmers in the rice fields.

Interestingly, he seems to abandon the superrealist techniques with which he has been so closely associated, choosing to adopt techniques taking inspiration from the colonial artists that have portrayed the country as the Beautiful Indies (Mooi Indie). Of course it is an anomaly, but these unique works are what is special in an artist's oeuvre.

## Isti by Jeihan Sukmatoro

Jeihan was best known for the black eyes in the figures in his paintings, which initially was a result of his failure in painting eyes realistically. Later, he realized that the black eyes served as a metaphor. Through the black eyes of the figures in his paintings, Jeihan suggests his viewers to always keep an open imagination about the things that could not be reached by the physical reach of humans alone through the open eye and to always look deeper and farther, like the black hole of the universe.

In this painting, he painted a young woman leisurely seated. Her eyes appear to be all black, as if they are empty. Might they be waiting to be filled with joy of something that she is longing for as she sits quietly, or will they soon be filled with a dream as she drifts into oblivion?

In this painting, he paints what seems to be a horizon: a small strip of dark blue above, and white below. Take a closer look and you will sas boats appear towards the intersection of the two colors. It is no longer lear whether it is the horizon that he painted. WHem viewing aJeihan's works it is best to always keep an open interpretation about the scene: it might be the horizon, or it might be the sea and sand, that you see. Either way, you should enjoy it nonetheless.

He creates tension by using orange and ochre colors on the right part of the sea, making it seem like it is about to soar up like a tsunami. However, like the black eyes of the figures in his paintings, he also seems to suggest his viewers to always keep an open interpretation about the waves: they might be deadly, but there is also hope that they could push the boats to safety

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
